15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 A. The Legislative Service Bureau shall contract for an
19 independent performance audit of the Human Services Centers in the
20 Department of Human Services including, but not limited to, the
21 Family Support Services Division, the Children and Family Services
22 Division, the Field Operations Division and all area and county
23 offices included therein. The audit shall be a comprehensive review

1 of the agency's operations in the Human Services Centers and shall
2 include, but not be limited to, a primary focus on:

- 3 1. Improving efficiency in management and structure;
- 4 2. Eliminating barriers in communications;
- 5 3. Reducing employee turnover;
- 6 4. Examining compensation-related issues;
- 7 5. Determining optimal training programs; and
- 8 6. Improving outcomes for individuals and families served by
9 the agency.

10 B. Upon completion of the audit, a final report with
11 recommendations shall be submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of
12 the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore
13 of the State Senate.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
