2 management license plate; creating the In God We
3 Trust special license plate; amending Section 14,
4 Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section

7 relates to special license plates; creating the

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1007, as last amended by Section 14, Chapter 62, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 11-1007), is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-1007. A. It shall be unlawful for any person to place or park a motor vehicle in any parking space that is designated and posted as a reserved area for the parking of a motor vehicle operated by or transporting a physically disabled person unless such person has applied for and been issued a detachable insignia indicating physical disability under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, and such insignia is displayed as

1 provided in Section 15-112 of this title or in rules adopted
2 pursuant thereto, ~~or~~ has applied for and been issued a physically
3 disabled special license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section
4 1135.1 of this title, and such license plate is displayed pursuant
5 to the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration
6 Act or has applied for and been issued a disabled veteran license
7 plate with the international accessibility symbol pursuant to the
8 provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, and such plate is
9 displayed pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License
10 and Registration Act. It shall also be unlawful for any person to
11 place or park a motor vehicle, whether with or without a physically
12 disabled placard or plate, in any disabled parking space access
13 aisle, wheelchair ramp, wheelchair loading/unloading area or any
14 portion thereof.

15 B. Violation of these provisions shall be a misdemeanor and
16 upon conviction such person shall be fined not less than One Hundred
17 Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) and not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars
18 (\$250.00). Provided, any person cited for a first offense of a
19 violation of this section who has displayed a placard which has
20 expired pursuant to paragraph 4 or 5 of subsection D of Section 15-
21 112 of this title shall be entitled to dismissal of such charge and
22 shall not be required to pay the fine or court costs if the person
23 presents to the court within thirty (30) days of the issuance of the
24 citation a notice from the Department of Public Safety that the

1 person has obtained a valid placard pursuant to the provisions of
2 subsection D of Section 15-112 of this title. In addition, vehicles
3 unlawfully parked in violation of these provisions shall be subject
4 to immediate tow by a licensed tow truck operator at the request of
5 the landowner or a duly appointed agent of the landowner, at the
6 request of any person unable to lawfully gain access to or move
7 their vehicle, at the request of any person unable to lawfully gain
8 access to the area blocked by the unlawfully parked vehicle, or at
9 the request of appropriate law-enforcement personnel. The owner of
10 any vehicle unlawfully parked in violation of these provisions shall
11 pay any and all reasonable and necessary costs associated with
12 towing and storage of the vehicle.

13 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 15-112, as
14 last amended by Section 17, Chapter 326, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp.
15 2007, Section 15-112), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 15-112. A. As used in this section:

17 1. "Physician" means any person holding a valid license to
18 practice medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine, chiropractic,
19 podiatric medicine, or optometry, pursuant to the state licensing
20 provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 2. "Physician assistant" means any person holding a valid
22 license as a physician assistant, pursuant to the state licensing
23 provisions of the Physician Assistant Act;

24

1 3. "Advanced registered nurse practitioner" means any person
2 who holds a current license as a registered nurse and a current
3 certificate of recognition for practice as an Advanced Registered
4 Nurse Practitioner as set forth in the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act
5 pursuant to the state licensing provisions contained in paragraph 5
6 of Section 567.3a of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

7 4. "Physical disability" means an illness, disease, injury or
8 condition by reason of which a person:

- 9 a. cannot walk two hundred (200) feet without stopping to
10 rest,
- 11 b. cannot walk without the use of or assistance from a
12 brace, cane, crutch, another person, prosthetic
13 device, wheelchair or other assistance device,
- 14 c. is restricted to such an extent that the person's
15 forced (respiratory) expiratory volume for one (1)
16 second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one
17 (1) liter, or the arterial oxygen tension is less than
18 sixty (60) mm/hg on room air at rest,
- 19 d. must use portable oxygen,
- 20 e. has functional limitations which are classified in
21 severity as Class III or Class IV according to
22 standards set by the American Heart Association,
- 23
24

- f. is severely limited in the person's ability to walk due to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic condition, or from complications due to pregnancy,
- g. is certified legally blind, or
- h. is missing one or more limbs.

B. 1. The Department of Public Safety shall issue a detachable placard indicating physical disability to any person who submits an application on a form furnished by the Department of Public Safety and certified by a physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner attesting that the applicant has a physical disability. The attestation of the physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner shall denote "temporary" as the type of placard requested and shall indicate an expiration date which the physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner estimates to be the date of termination of such physical disability; however, if the physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner certifies that the physical disability is permanent, the physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner shall denote "five-year" as the type of placard requested.

2. The person to whom such placard is issued shall be entitled to the special parking privileges provided for in Section 15-111 of this title; provided, however, the placard is properly displayed on the parked vehicle.

1 C. Any placard issued by the Department of Public Safety shall
2 remain valid until:

3 1. The placard expires;

4 2. The person to whom the placard was issued requests a
5 replacement placard; or

6 3. The placard is no longer needed by the person to whom the
7 placard was issued for the disability for which the placard was
8 originally issued, whereupon such placard shall be returned to the
9 Department of Public Safety.

10 D. 1. A five-year placard shall expire five (5) years from the
11 last day of the month in which the placard was issued. Upon the
12 expiration of a five-year placard, the person to whom such placard
13 was issued may obtain a subsequent placard by reapplying to the
14 Department of Public Safety, in the same manner as provided in
15 subsection B of this section.

16 2. A temporary placard shall indicate the expiration date which
17 the physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse
18 practitioner certifying the physical disability estimates to be the
19 date of termination of such physical disability, which shall not be
20 later than six (6) months from the date of issuance and upon which
21 date such placard shall expire and shall be returned to the
22 Department of Public Safety; provided, however, nothing in this
23 paragraph shall be construed to prevent the holder from applying for
24 another placard, as provided for in this section.

1 3. In the event that a placard is lost or destroyed, the person
2 to whom such placard was issued may apply in writing to the
3 Department of Public Safety for a replacement placard, which the
4 Department of Public Safety shall issue with the same expiration
5 date as the original placard.

6 4. On and after January 1, 1998, all placards issued prior to
7 October 31, 1990, shall expire on the last day of the month in which
8 the placard was issued, and the person to whom such placard was
9 issued may follow the procedure provided for in subsection B of this
10 section to obtain a second or subsequent placard.

11 5. On and after January 1, 2000, all placards issued between
12 November 1, 1990, and June 30, 1995, shall expire on the last day of
13 the birth month of the person to whom the placard was issued, and
14 the person to whom such placard was issued may follow the procedure
15 provided for in subsection B of this section to obtain a second or
16 subsequent placard.

17 E. A physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered
18 nurse practitioner may sign an application certifying that a person
19 has a physical disability, as provided in subsection B of this
20 section, only if care and treatment of the illness, disease, injury
21 or condition causing the physical disability of such person falls
22 within the authorized scope of practice of the physician or
23 physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner.

1 F. The Department of Public Safety shall recognize handicap and
2 disability stickers issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs and
3 federal military bases and disabled veterans license plate with the
4 international accessibility symbol, issued pursuant to the
5 provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title in the same manner as the
6 placard issued by the Department of Public Safety as provided for in
7 this section. For purposes of this section and other sections of
8 law relating to the physical disability placard, the term "physical
9 disability placard" shall include those handicap and disability
10 stickers issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs and federal
11 military bases and disabled veterans license plate with the
12 international accessibility symbol, issued pursuant to the
13 provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title.

14 G. The Department of Public Safety shall have the power to
15 formulate, adopt and promulgate rules as may be necessary to
16 implement and administer the provisions of this section, including,
17 but not limited to, prescribing the manner in which the placard is
18 to be displayed on a motor vehicle.

19 H. The Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby authorized to
20 enter into reciprocity agreements with other states for the purpose
21 of recognizing parking placards or license plates indicating
22 physical disability issued by those states.

23 I. The Department of Public Safety shall charge and the
24 applicant shall pay to the Department of Public Safety a fee of One

1 Dollar (\$1.00) for each placard issued. The fee shall be deposited
2 in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

3 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
4 2004, as last amended by Section 31, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S.
5 Supp. 2007, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

6 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
7 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
8 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
9 provided by this section.

10 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
11 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
12 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
13 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
14 registered for the current year.

15 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
16 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
17 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
18 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
19 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
20 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
21 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
22 amateur radio operator license plates.

23
24

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
17 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
18 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
19 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
20 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
21 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
22 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
23 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
4 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

6 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
8 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
9 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
10 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

11 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
17 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
18 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
19 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
20 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
21 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
22 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
23 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
24 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or

1 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
2 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
3 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
4 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
6 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
7 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
8 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
10 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

11 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
13 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
14 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
16 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
17 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
18 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
19 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
20 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
21 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
22 of one (1) ton or less;

23 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper

1 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
2 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
3 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
4 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
5 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
6 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
7 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
8 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
9 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
10 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

11 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
13 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
14 the United States as being:

- 15 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
16 7, 1941,
17 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
18 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
19 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
20 exceed three (3) miles, and
21 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
22 States Armed Forces.

23
24

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
24 registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
6 1944,

7 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
8 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
9 participation cannot be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
11 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
12 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star ~~Parents~~ License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
10 killed during a war. The parents or surviving spouse of the
11 deceased person may apply for a gold star ~~parents~~ license plate upon
12 presenting proper certification that the person was killed during a
13 war and that the person making the application is the parent or
14 surviving spouse of the deceased person. The parent or surviving
15 spouse may apply for a gold star ~~parent~~ license plate for no more
16 than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity
17 of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the
18 special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in
19 addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the
20 registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

21 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
23 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
24 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or

1 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
2 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
3 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

4 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
6 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
7 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
8 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for any currently employed or retired municipal or
11 university police officer. Police officers may apply for police
12 officer license plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1)
13 ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of employment by or
14 retirement from a municipal or university police department by
15 either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police
16 department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
20 designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this
21 state; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar
22 design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new
23 design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license
24 plate;

1 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
3 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
4 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
5 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
6 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
7 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
8 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
9 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

10 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
11 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
12 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
13 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
14 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
15 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
16 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
17 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
18 bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II";

19 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
21 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
22 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
23 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
24 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June

1 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
2 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
3 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

4 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
5 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
6 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
7 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
8 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
9 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
10 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
11 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
12 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

13 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
15 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
16 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
17 be produced upon application;

18 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
20 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
21 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
22 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
23 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
24 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the

1 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
2 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
3 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
4 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
5 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
6 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
7 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

8 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
10 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
11 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
12 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
13 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
14 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

15 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
16 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
17 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
18 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
19 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
20 of one (1) ton or less;

21 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
23 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
24

1 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
2 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
4 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
5 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
6 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

7 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
9 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
10 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
11 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

13 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
15 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
16 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 the Ninety-Nines;

18 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
19 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
20 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
21 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
22 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
23 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate

24

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
2 less;

3 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
5 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
6 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
7 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
8 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
11 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
12 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
13 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

14 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
16 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
17 United States Secretary of Defense;

18 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
20 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
21 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
22 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
23 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
24 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
3 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
4 district number;

5 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
7 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
8 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
9 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
10 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
11 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
12 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
13 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
14 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
15 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
16 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
17 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
19 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
20 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
21 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
23 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
24 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other

1 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
2 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
3 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

4 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
5 and is also eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person
6 under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person
7 shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that
8 also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a
9 stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the
10 disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
11 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
12 the Tax Commission;

13 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
15 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
16 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Association;

18 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
19 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
20 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
21 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
22 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
23 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
24

1 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
2 Academy;

3 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
5 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
6 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
7 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
8 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
9 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
10 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
11 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Oklahoma
12 Tax Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
13 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
14 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
15 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
16 applications for such plates must be made to the Oklahoma Tax
17 Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for
18 such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied
19 by the fee required in this section together with a certificate, or
20 such other evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that
21 applicant has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's
22 license and proof of his ownership of a vehicle in which radio
23 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
24 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any

1 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
2 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
3 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
4 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

5 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
7 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
9 Oklahoma;

10 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
12 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
13 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
14 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
15 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
16 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
17 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
18 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
19 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
20 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
21 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
22 state;

23 38. Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state who is the surviving spouse

1 of an honorably discharged veteran who died due to or as a
2 consequence of a service-connected disability. Such surviving
3 spouse may, if not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage
4 is terminated by death, divorce or annulment, apply for a Surviving
5 Spouse license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
6 of one (1) ton or less;

7 39. Gold Star Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed to honor the surviving spouses of qualified veterans. As
9 used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran" shall mean:

- 10 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
11 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
12 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
13 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
14 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
15 while on active military duty, or
- 16 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
17 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
18 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
19 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
20 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
21 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
22 discharge of such person;

23 40. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has

1 | been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
2 | Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
3 | Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
4 | capacity of one (1) ton or less; and

5 | 41. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
6 | designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
7 | Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
8 | proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
9 | license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
10 | Infantry;

11 | 42. Veteran Motorcycle License Plates - such plates shall be
12 | designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
13 | States Armed Forces who are residents of this state whose service
14 | can be verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department
15 | of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States.
16 | Veterans may apply for veteran motorcycle license plates for a
17 | motorcycle upon proof of prior service. The license plates shall be
18 | designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Military Department;

19 | 43. Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom
20 | Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to
21 | any honorably discharged or present member of the United States
22 | Armed Forces who served in Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation
23 | Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Operation Iraqi
24 | Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for

1 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;
2 and

3 44. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to persons who are involved in the
5 state civil emergency management system. These license plates shall
6 only be issued upon proof of involvement in the civil emergency
7 management system by either an identification card, certificate of
8 appointment, or official approval letter from the jurisdiction
9 represented.

10 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
11 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
12 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
13 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
14 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
15 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

16 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
17 2004, as last amended by Section 35, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S.
18 Supp. 2007, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
20 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
21 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
22 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
23 subject as provided by this section.

24

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
23 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
24 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
13 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
14 Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the effective
15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

19 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
20 follows:

21 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 round and square dancing;

4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

7 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
9 Association;

10 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
12 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
13 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
15 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
16 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
17 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
19 contain the Masonic emblem;

20 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
21 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
22 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
24 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

3 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
5 ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
8 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
24

1 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
2 Columbus emblem;

3 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
4 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
5 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

7 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
9 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
10 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
11 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

12 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
14 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
15 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with Kiwanis International;

17 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
19 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
20 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
22 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
23 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
24 Accountants;

1 ~~13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates~~
2 ~~shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate~~
3 ~~support for the state civil emergency management system;~~

4 ~~14.~~ Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
5 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
8 Conservation Corps;

9 ~~15.~~ 14. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a
11 Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian
12 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
13 (1) ton or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
14 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
15 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
17 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

5 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L.

9 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
10 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
11 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
12 financial assistance as provided by this section.

13 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
17 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
19 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
20 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
21 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
22 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
23 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
24 issued on a staggered system.

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
14 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
15 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
16 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
17 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
18 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
19 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
20 removed from the vehicle.

21 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
22 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
23 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
24 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by

1 the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the
2 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
3 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
4 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
5 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

6 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
7 follows:

8 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
11 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

13 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
18 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
19 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
21 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
22 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
23 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
24 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee

1 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
2 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
3 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
4 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

5 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

7 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
8 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
9 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
10 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
11 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
12 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
13 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
14 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
15 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
16 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
17 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
18 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
19 of the fire department.

20 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
21 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
22 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
23 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
24 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color

1 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
2 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
3 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
4 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
5 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
6 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
7 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
8 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
11 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
12 Living Memorial;

13 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
18 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
19 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
20 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
21 plates.

22 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
23 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
24 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
4 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
5 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the prevention of child abuse.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

9 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
10 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
12 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
13 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
14 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
15 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
16 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
17 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
18 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
19 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
20 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
21 issued;

22 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
24 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee

1 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
2 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

3 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
5 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
7 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
8 Oklahoma;

9 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
11 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
12 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
13 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
14 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
15 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
18 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
19 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
21 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
22 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
23 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
24 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the

1 person purchasing the plates to be equally apportioned by the county
2 to the city and county volunteer fire departments in the county;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
7 Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
23 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
24 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

1 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
2 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
3 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
5 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
6 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
7 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 1104.4 of this title;

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
13 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
14 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
15 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
16 Section 1104.3 of this title;

17 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
19 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
22 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
24

1 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
2 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
10 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
11 follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 14 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
15 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
17 Career Technology Fund, and
- 18 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
19 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
20 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes.

9 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
10 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
13 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
14 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
16 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
18 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
20 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

21 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
23 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
24 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters

1 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
2 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
3 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
4 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
5 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
6 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
7 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
8 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
13 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
14 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
16 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
17 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
22 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
24

1 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
2 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

3 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
4 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
5 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
6 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
7 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
8 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
9 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
10 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human

18 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
19 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
20 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
21 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
