1 WHEREAS, Payne County will host the second annual Oklahoma
2 Celtic Music and Heritage Festival, sponsored by the Oklahoma Celtic
3 Heritage Association, on June 21 and 22, 2008, at the Payne County
4 Expo Center in Stillwater, Oklahoma; and

5 WHEREAS, the festival will showcase the music, dance, arts,
6 crafts, and heritage of Ireland, Scotland, Wales, and other Celtic
7 countries whose descendants settled in Payne County and throughout
8 Oklahoma; and

9 WHEREAS, the United Scottish Clans of Oklahoma, the Tulsa Irish
10 American Club, and the Tulsa Gaelic Studies Group have joined
11 together in conjunction with the Oklahoma Celtic Heritage
12 Association to create a celebration with an exploration of history
13 dance, culture, and music from Ireland, Wales, Cornwall, Galacia,
14 Brittany, Scotland, and the Isle of Man; and
