1       WHEREAS, Route 66, the famous American highway, was established  
2 in 1926; and

3       WHEREAS, Route 66 traveled through eight states, beginning in  
4 Illinois and ending in California; and

5       WHEREAS, it is recognized that the State of Oklahoma has more  
6 surviving miles of Route 66 than any other state; and

7       WHEREAS, many individuals and organizations within the State of  
8 Oklahoma use their special talents, skills, and resources in order  
9 to celebrate, preserve, and explore this American phenomenon; and

10       WHEREAS, it is recognized that Creek County uniquely celebrates  
11 the spirit of Route 66 each year by holding the Route 66 Blowout and  
12 Car Show in downtown Sapulpa, drawing numerous participants and  
13 thousands of happy spectators, and the Creek County Sheriff Reserve  
14 Deputies Route 66 Car Show at the Creek County fairgrounds, both of  
15 which celebrate the classic automobiles that have traversed the  
16 Mother Road.
