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8 A Joint Resolution disapproving, in part, permanent
9 rules of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts
Commission; and directing distribution.

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12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate
14 the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a
15 rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any
16 rule or portion thereof at any time; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 582 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
18 Statutes, the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission shall
19 be responsible for adopting and promulgating rules as necessary and
20 appropriate to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the
21 Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission; and

22 WHEREAS, the promulgation of permanent new rule OAC 765:13-3-3
23 which was finally adopted by the Commission on February 12, 2008,
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1 setting forth the content of information on a temporary license tag,
2 does not entirely reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves, in part, OAC
6 765:13-3-3(c), deleting the following language: "centered in an
7 area below the date rectangles", "centered in an area above the date
8 rectangles", and "and 'Purchaser's Name',".

9 SECTION 2. Taking into account the disapproved language,
10 subsection (c) shall read as follows: "The temporary license plate
11 shall have the following preprinted language: The selling dealer's
12 company name, the word 'Oklahoma' or 'Okla', and the words '30 Day
13 Temporary Tag' and a line with the words 'Vehicle Year', 'Make',
14 'Model', below the line."

15 SECTION 3. The Legislature hereby disapproves, in part, OAC
16 765:13-3-3(d), deleting the following language: "the selling
17 dealer's license number and", "both of which shall be preprinted on
18 the same line in black ink,", and "with the license number and
19 sequential number separated by a hyphen, creating a unique
20 sequential number for each temporary license plate. This unique
21 sequential number to be located in an area between 3.5 inches and
22 4.75 inches below the top of the 6-inch wide temporary license plate
23 and proportionally located on the motorcycle temporary license
24 plate."

1 SECTION 4. Taking into account the disapproved language,
2 subsection (d) shall read: "In addition to the preprinted
3 information recited in paragraphs (a) and (c), the temporary license
4 plate shall have preprinted a sequential number of no fewer than six
5 digits, approximately one inch in height. The height of the
6 preprinted unique sequential number for a motorcycle temporary
7 license plate shall be no less than 1/2 inch. The dealer shall
8 record the temporary license plate's unique sequential number on the
9 front of the vehicle's bill of sale in a conspicuous location. A
10 dealer shall not issue more than one unique sequentially numbered
11 temporary license plate for the same vehicle sale."

12 SECTION 5. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute
13 copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Chairperson of the
14 Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission, and the editor of
15 "The Oklahoma Register".
