13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Capitol
15 Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission from any monies not
16 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
17 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of
18 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
19 to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and
20 Centennial Commemoration Commission by law.

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
22 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission
23 shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
3 the budget category.

4 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration
7 Commission by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and
8 Centennial Commemoration Commission. The salary of the Executive
9 Director shall be set by the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
10 Commemoration Commission and shall not exceed _____ Dollars
11 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
12 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration
13 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
14 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
15 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
16 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
17 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
18 Statutes:
