13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
15 Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the
16 following categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the
6 Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The salary of the Executive
7 Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall not exceed
8 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Conservation
10 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
11 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
12 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
13 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
14 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
15 Statutes:
