13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Corporation
15 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Corporation Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
21 Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following
22 categories and amounts:

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
15 upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the General
16 Administrator. The Salary of the General Administrator of the
17 Corporation Commission shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
18 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
19 The Corporation Commission shall be subject to the following
20 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
21 expenditures excluding direct expenditures for well plugging as
22 authorized in Section 310 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pit
23 closure as authorized in Section 140 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes, and remediation of sites as authorized in Section 353 of

1 Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as may be authorized pursuant
2 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes:
