13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Horse
15 Racing Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
18 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
21 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law shall be set by the
10 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
11 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission for the
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following
14 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
15 expenditures excluding expenditures from the Oklahoma Breeding
16 Development Revolving Fund, except as may be authorized pursuant to
17 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
