12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Court
14 of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

18 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
19 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
20 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law shall be set by the Judges
21 of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The Court of Criminal Appeals,
22 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
23 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
