13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
15 State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Office
21 of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following
22 categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the
10 State Fire Marshal. The salary of the State Fire Marshal shall not
11 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Office of the State Fire
13 Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject
14 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
15 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
16 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
17 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
