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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Office
15 of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following
16 categories and amounts:

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
3 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the
4 State Fire Marshal. The salary of the State Fire Marshal shall not
5 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
6 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Office of the State
7 Fire Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
8 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
9 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
10 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
11 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes:
