12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
14 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System shall budget all funds in the
15 following categories and amounts:

21 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
22 each budget category.

23 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law shall be set by the
2 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System. The
3 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System for the fiscal year ending June 30,
4 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
5 full-time-equivalent employees, except those used for the statewide
6 Trial Indigent Defense System, and expenditures, except as may be
7 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
8 the Oklahoma Statutes:
