13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on
15 Judicial Complaints from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
21 Council on Judicial Complaints shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law shall be set by the
8 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed

9 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the

10 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Council on Judicial
11 Complaints for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
12 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
13 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
14 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
15 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
16 Statutes:
