12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
14 Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
20 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the
14 Commissioner. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year
15 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
16 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures,
17 except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include
18 cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their
19 employment in probationary status, excluding expenditures for
20 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
21 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes:
