7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
8 designating memorial roads and bridges; requiring  
9 placement of markers; providing for codification; and  
10 declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall  
16 be designated the "Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S.  
17 Army 3rd Infantry Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
19 upon the bridge bearing that name.

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton  
24 shall be designated the "Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of

1 the Oklahoma House of Representatives Memorial Highway". The  
2 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
3 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

4 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless  
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of State Highway 9 from Skagg City Road east to the  
8 intersection of State Highway 9-A in Pottawatomie County shall be  
9 designated the "U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Ruben Rivers Highway". SSG  
10 Ruben Rivers was killed in action during World War II on November  
11 19, 1944. He was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his  
12 heroic efforts as a member of the 761st Tank Battalion, the first  
13 African-American armored unit to serve in combat. In addition to  
14 the Medal of Honor, Staff Sergeant Rivers was awarded the Silver  
15 Star for previous action with his battalion. The Department of  
16 Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that  
17 section of highway bearing that name.

18 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
