11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1362 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or
16 maliciously cause to be emitted from any vehicle any loud or obscene
17 music which harasses another person and is broadcast in the presence
18 of a minor and can be heard from a distance of fifty (50) feet or
19 more whether the vehicle emitting such music has its windows open or
20 closed, and the words broadcast in the music are prohibited from
21 being broadcast on any communications network regulated by the
22 Federal Communication Commission.

23 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of
24 subsection A of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor

1 punishable by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred and Fifty
2 Dollars (\$350.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period
3 of not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and
4 imprisonment.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
