18 Star Spencer High School Bobcat senior Raymond Lane  
19 for his two consecutive Class 3A State Wrestling  
20 Championships and his commitment to his family; and  
21 directing distribution.

22 WHEREAS, Raymond Lane, Star Spencer High School Bobcat wrestler,  
23 won his second consecutive State Championship this year, thus  
24 becoming the first two-time Class 3A state champion in Star Spencer

1 history. The 189-pound Lane has compiled a 42-1 record as a senior  
2 at Star Spencer High School; and

3 WHEREAS, in recognition of his outstanding performance, Raymond  
4 Lane was voted the 2008 Senior Outstanding Wrestler for all classes  
5 by the Oklahoma Wrestling Coaches Association and was selected to  
6 the All State team by the Oklahoma Coaches Association. Raymond is  
7 also a two-time, All-City selectee of the Oklahoman newspaper; and

8 WHEREAS, Raymond began wrestling as a fifth grader at Jefferson  
9 Middle School in Oklahoma City. For Raymond, wrestling has served  
10 as a positive outlet and, because of his determination and success,  
11 he has parlayed this experience into an opportunity to pursue higher  
12 education. Raymond Lane recently signed a letter of intent to  
13 attend Oklahoma City University where he has earned a full four-year  
14 scholarship in wrestling; and

15 WHEREAS, Raymond Lane enthusiastically shares his feeling about  
16 his family as the center of his life. When Raymond's father, Henry  
17 Lane, died of a heart attack, then five-year-old Raymond became and  
18 has been the "man of the house." To support his family Raymond  
19 stocks shelves at Wal-Mart, works at a local swimming pool, and  
20 builds fences, all the while maintaining the level of discipline to  
21 his sport that has resulted in this outstanding accomplishment.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
23 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
24 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1            THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature congratulates Star Spencer  
2 High School Bobcat senior Raymond Lane for his two consecutive Class  
3 3A State Wrestling Championships at the 189-pound weight class.

4            THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature commends Raymond Lane for  
5 his dedication to his family and his sport, and wishes him continued  
6 success at Oklahoma City University and in all of his future  
7 endeavors.

8            THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Star Spencer  
9 High School Bobcat wrestling star and senior Raymond Lane and the  
10 Star Spencer High School Head Wrestling Coach Dana Johns.
