9 A Concurrent Resolution honoring the accomplishments  
10 of the Broken Arrow Police Department; and directing  
11 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, The 2007 Uniform Crime Report issued by the Federal  
13 Bureau of Investigation named the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma the  
14 twenty-second safest city in the United States; and

15 WHEREAS, The Federal Bureau of Investigation examines  
16 demographics, law enforcement services, crime rates, and other data  
17 for communities of similar size in compiling the Uniform Crime  
18 Report; and

19 WHEREAS, The Broken Arrow Police Department ranked near the top  
20 in crime clearance rates and in investigations of a number of crime  
21 types, including violent crimes, fraud, domestic violence, and  
22 recovery of stolen property; and

1       WHEREAS, The Broken Arrow Police Department achieved a superior  
2 rating in total training hours while maintaining the second lowest  
3 overall cost per citizen for police services; and

4       WHEREAS, Broken Arrow was named the safest city in Oklahoma for  
5 the third consecutive year; and

6       WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Broken Arrow and the State  
7 of Oklahoma value, appreciate and honor the public service offered  
8 each day by the Broken Arrow Police Department in its dedication to  
9 all.

10       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
11 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
12 CONCURRING THEREIN:

13       THAT the Oklahoma Legislature congratulates and honors the  
14 Broken Arrow Police Department for its exemplary service, its  
15 deserved recognition and its continued achievement as one of the  
16 finest law enforcement services in the nation.
