An Act relating to the State Board of Education;  
making appropriation to the State Board of  
Education; stating purpose; making appropriation  
nonfiscal; making appropriation exempt from certain  
agency category and budget limits; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, the sum of Nineteen Million Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand Thirty-two Dollars (\$19,213,032.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 2. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal years 2008 and 2009 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
