An Act relating to the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund; providing for transfer of certain funds if certain legislation is enacted into law; limiting purpose of expenditures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER A. The Director of State Finance shall transfer in monthly installments from the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund created in Section 113 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes an amount equal to the fees collected pursuant to subsection E of Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 3326 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature to the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund created in Section 2-144.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. These funds shall be used by the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of supporting the Driver License Examining Division created in Section 2-106 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The provisions of this section shall be applicable only if House Bill No. 3326 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature is enacted into law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby decllared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
