An Act relating to labor; requiring Oklahoma  
Employment Security Commission to implement certain  
electronic filing procedures; providing for  
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-118 of Title 40, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

By December 31, 2008, the Oklahoma Employment Security  
Commission shall provide a method for employers to file the  
Employer's Quarterly Contributions and Wage Report for Oklahoma  
state unemployment taxes through the Internet. The Oklahoma  
Employment Security Commission shall also provide by December 31,  
2008, a method for employers to pay Oklahoma state unemployment  
taxes through an electronic payment system utilizing the Internet.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
