An Act relating to cities and towns; modifying general powers of municipalities; requiring certification training for certain municipal employees; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 111.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Employees of a municipality employed or otherwise assigned to enforce provisions of Section 22-111 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall complete certification training specifically applicable to such section as adopted and administered by the Oklahoma Code Enforcement Association, an internationally recognized model code organization, career technical education program, or an institution of higher education. The certification training shall be completed within one (1) year of employment or assignment for such enforcement.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 112.2 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Employees of a municipality assigned to enforce provisions of Sections 22-112 and 22-112.1 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall complete certification training specifically applicable to such section as adopted and administered by the Oklahoma Code

Enforcement Association, an internationally recognized model code organization, career technical education program, or an institution of higher education. The certification training shall be completed within one (1) year of employment or assignment for such enforcement.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
