An Act relating to definitions and general
provisions; directing state agencies and political
subdivisions to purchase certain flags manufactured
in the United States; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158 of Title 25, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All state agencies and political subdivisions shall only
purchase flags of the United States and state flags of Oklahoma that
are manufactured in the United States. A flag is manufactured in

the United States if a substantial majority of the principal components are assembled into the final product in an assembly plant in the United States.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
