An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; providing certain benefits to Oklahoma veterans; providing certain identification requirements; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All honorably discharged veterans who are currently Oklahoma residents shall be allowed free admission to all state-owned or state-operated parks and museums. A valid Oklahoma driver license or state photo identification card and military discharge papers (DD Form 214) or similar evidence of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces shall be required for free admission.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
