WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature was founded in 1969 by Governor George Nigh and by college students across Oklahoma, in order to provide a networking opportunity and a wide array of experience to students with an interest in politics, law, or Oklahoma state government; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature is the longest consecutively running higher education mock legislative body in the nation; and

WHEREAS, each semester the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature hosts a five-day mock legislative session in the Oklahoma State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, the mock parliamentary body consists of delegations from over twenty instate universities; and

WHEREAS, the legislation that is passed from the mock session is forwarded to active legislators who review each for consideration of adopting into law; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that many current and former legislators and elected officials are alumni of the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature is celebrating its 40th legislative session, and will commemorate this event with a banquet on April 4, 2008, honoring special alumni and celebrating its forty years of leadership and service.
