A Concurrent Resolution relating to the sine die adjournment of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature; providing for extension of sine die adjournment.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate have adopted Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 71 fixing the date and time of sine die adjournment of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature as May 23, 2008, at 5 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature may require additional time authorized pursuant to Section 26 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution in order to consider and pass measures that are of importance that would otherwise remain on the respective calendars of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate if the prescribed sine die adjournment date of May 23 occurred; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of the Oklahoma House of Representatives require the Presiding Officer of the House to declare the session adjourned sine die if the date and time of such adjournment has been fixed; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate mutually agree to extend the date and time for the sine die adjournment of the 2nd Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate rescind the proposed sine die adjournment date of May 23, 2008, at 5 p.m. as contained in Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 71 of the 2nd Session of the 51st Legislature.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate will adjourn sine die at such time as may be declared by the Presiding Officer of the respective chambers but in no case later than Friday, May 23, 2008, at midnight.
