A Joint Resolution memorializing the United States Department of Defense and the United States Department of Labor to include the State of Oklahoma in the Military Spouse Career Advancement Initiative program; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Oklahoma citizens play a critical role in the United States military and a large number of Oklahoma's citizens are directly or indirectly involved in the military; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense and the United States Department of Labor have established the Military Spouse Career Advancement Initiative program which provides educational assistance to the spouses of active duty service members in a limited number of states; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma active duty members and their spouses deserve recognition for the sacrifices that they make on a daily basis in defense of this country; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma military members and their spouses should be afforded the full benefit of federal programs available to other service members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Legislature memorializes the United States Department of Defense and the United States Department of Labor to include Oklahoma in the Military Spouse Career Advancement Initiative.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor of Oklahoma, the Secretary of the Department of Defense, and the Secretary of the United States Department of Labor.
