A Joint Resolution approving permanent rules of the Oklahoma State Board of Career and Technology Education; directing distribution; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, approve, delay, suspend, veto, or amend the implementation of any rule or proposed rule while under review by the Legislature, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent, and suspend any rule or any portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 14-104 and 14-108 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the State Board of Career and Technology Education shall be responsible for promulgating and adopting rules as necessary and appropriate for the administration and operation of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, as well as to prescribe criteria and procedures for the establishment and governance of technology center school districts; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that proposed permanent rules OAC 780:1-13-1, OAC 780:10-3-2, OAC 780:10-3-3, OAC 780:10-3-11, OAC 780:10-3-12, OAC 780:10-9-1, OAC 780:15-3-1, OAC 780:15-3-2, OAC 780:15-3-4, OAC 780:15-3-6, OAC 780:15-3-7, OAC 780:15-3-8, OAC 780:20-1-1, OAC 780:20-1-2, OAC 780:20-3-1 and OAC 780:20-3-2, which were adopted by the State Board of Career and Technology Education on March 27, 2008, and submitted for consideration to the Governor

and the Legislature on April 2, 2008, are consistent with legislative intent and the public policy of this state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby approves proposed permanent rules OAC 780:1-13-1, OAC 780:10-3-2, OAC 780:10-3-3, OAC 780:10-3-11, OAC 780:10-3-12, OAC 780:10-9-1, OAC 780:15-3-1, OAC 780:15-3-2, OAC 780:15-3-4, OAC 780:15-3-6, OAC 780:15-3-7, OAC 780:15-3-8, OAC 780:20-1-1, OAC 780:20-1-2, OAC 780:20-3-1 and OAC 780:20-3-2.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register."

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
