WHEREAS, Randy Tonche was born June 10, 1988, and started to wrestle at the age of six years. As a freshman, he won the Junior High All-State Championship; and

WHEREAS, in his senior year at Sallisaw High School, Randy Tonche accumulated a 27-0 record to win the Class 3A State Wrestling Championship at 215 pounds. He won the Oklahoma Coaches Association All-State Maverick Conference Championship with a 4-0 record in the finals; and

WHEREAS, Randy Tonche compiled an overall career record of 120 wins and 7 losses and a high school record of 100 wins and 7 losses. He was state runner-up as a sophomore and junior at 189 pounds; and

WHEREAS, Randy Tonche was a three-sport athlete at Sallisaw High School, in Sallisaw, Oklahoma. He ran track in the spring and played football in the fall. He ran a 49.74 to take the gold medal in the 400 meter dash at the 2007 Class 4A State Track & Field Championship. On the football field, he was selected Defensive Player of the Year for Sallisaw and voted District 4A-4 Defensive End/Linebacker of the Year. He is now attending Northeastern Oklahoma A&M College on a football scholarship; and

WHEREAS, Randy Tonche has a strong work ethic, a determination never to quit, and a desire to win, which results in successful athletic competition. It is no surprise his favorite movie is "Rocky IV".
