An Act relating to children; expanding certain
jurisdiction; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7002-1.3 of Title 10, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The judge presiding over a deprived action shall also have
jurisdiction to make a final determination in the matter and preside
over any separate action necessary to finalize a child's court-
approved permanency plan, including an adoption, guardianship, or
other custody proceeding.
