An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1760, which relates to malicious injury or destruction of property; making language gender neutral; modifying valuation of certain offense; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1760, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1760. A. Every person who maliciously injures, defaces or destroys any real or personal property not his or her own, in cases other than such as are specified in Section 1761 et seq. of this title, is guilty of:

1. A misdemeanor, if the damage, defacement or destruction causes a loss which ~~is valued at~~ has an aggregate value of less than ~~Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)~~ One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); ~~or~~

2. A felony, if the damage, defacement or destruction causes a loss which ~~is valued at Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)~~ has an aggregate value of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or more; or

3. A felony, if the defendant has two or more prior convictions for an offense under this section, notwithstanding the value of loss caused by the damage, defacement or destruction.

B. In addition to any other punishment prescribed by law for violations of subsection A of this section, he or she is liable in treble damages for the injury done, to be recovered in a civil action by the owner of such property or public officer having charge thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
