A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Howe Lady Lions basketball team for winning the 2008 Class A State Championship; commending their tradition and determination; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, to fully understand the accomplishments of the 2008 Howe Lady Lions basketball team it is necessary to know their history. A year ago they lost the 2007 Class A State Championship by a single point. The Monday morning following the loss, the team was practicing in the gym despite the fact that the coach was willing to give them some time off; and

WHEREAS, the Howe Lady Lions won the LeFlore County Tournament championship this year, adding to their victories in 2003 and 2004. The tournament, which began in 1932, is more than three-quarters of a century old and holds great significance to the participants; and

WHEREAS, the Howe Lady Lions basketball team won their final game 53-41 to win the 2008 Class A State Championship in front of 5,000 fans in the State Fair Arena in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. They did so in the final minutes at the free-throw line where the Lady

Lions lost the Gold Ball the previous year. The "Tulsa World" selected four of the Lady Lions on their first team Girls Class A All Tournament Team and two of them as co-Most Valuable Players; and

WHEREAS, the 2008 Howe Lady Lions basketball team won the fourth state championship in school history, finishing the season with a 28-2 record, winning their last 19 games, and all seven playoff games by an average margin of 15 points.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
