A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Guthrie High School Bluejays Boys Basketball Team for winning the 2008 Class 5A State Championship; commending their record; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the 2007-2008 Guthrie High School Bluejays Boys Basketball Team won the 2008 Class 5A State Championship, the school's sixth and the first in 39 years; and

WHEREAS, the 2007-2008 Guthrie High School Bluejays Boys Basketball Team demonstrated collective coolness under pressure as they won a number of close games in the last seconds, including a 50-48 victory over Tulsa Edison, to advance to the Class 5A Championship game where they prevailed over Tulsa's Booker T. Washington 58-57. The Bluejays won the Titan Classic where they defeated Tulsa Union 50-48 and Midwest City 49-48. They also triumphed in a 75-73 double-overtime victory over Stillwater; and
