A survivor of such abuse, she regularly spends time with the girls at the Marie Detty Girls Home in Lawton, Oklahoma, where she shares her story with the girls. Brooke Good was crowned Mrs. Oklahoma International 2007 by her husband on Mother's Day weekend last year in Bartlesville, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, since being selected as Mrs. Oklahoma International 2007, "Brookie", as she is known, helped celebrate the 2007 National Book Festival with the First Book team at Science Museum Oklahoma in Oklahoma City, and participated in a rally against child abuse sponsored by Mothers Against Sexual Abuse. She also attended the Mrs. International 2007 pageant in Chicago, Illinois, last July.
