A Resolution celebrating CompSource Oklahoma on April 7, 2008; honoring CompSource Oklahoma for its dedication and service to the employers and workers of the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, CompSource Oklahoma was created by the Legislature on April 4, 1933, to provide a consistent, viable market for Oklahoma employers to obtain affordable, service-oriented workers' compensation coverage; and

WHEREAS, then Governor "Alfalfa Bill" Murray signed the legislation into law on April 7, 1933; and

WHEREAS, CompSource Oklahoma's mission is to partner with all Oklahoma employers as the source for their workers' compensation needs; and

WHEREAS, CompSource Oklahoma provides workers' compensation coverage to more than 28,000 policyholders, large and small, including employers who are unable to obtain coverage elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, April 7, 2008, marks CompSource Oklahoma's 75th year of existence.
