12 I move to amend the amendment to House Bill No. 3229, Page 16, Line 17, as follows:

13 By deleting all language on Line 17 and inserting the following NEW SECTIONS 5 and 6 to
14 read as follows:

15 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes

16 as Section 302-5a of Title 68, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Notwithstanding the rate of tax levied upon the sale, use, gift, possession, or consumption of
18 cigarettes within the State of Oklahoma pursuant to Sections 302, 302-1, 302-2, 302-3, 302-4 and
19 302-5 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the sale, use, exchange or possession of articles
20 containing tobacco within the State of Oklahoma pursuant to Sections 402, 402-1, 402-2 and 402-3
21 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if any compact between the State of Oklahoma and a federally
22 recognized Indian tribe or nation enacted or amended after January 1, 2004 reduces the percentage
23 of the tax levied on such cigarette and tobacco products at tribally owned or licensed stores, such
24 percentage reduction shall apply to the tax levied on such cigarettes and tobacco products pursuant
25 to the provisions of Sections 302, 302-1, 302-2, 302-3, 302-4, 302-5, 402, 402-1, 402-2 and 402-3 of
26 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

28 SECTION 6. The effective date of Sections 1 through 5 of this act shall become effective
29 November 1, 2008.
