Mr./Madame President:

I move to amend Senate Bill No. 1604, Page 1, Line 25, as follows:

By inserting a new Section 2 as follows and amending the title to conform.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 78e of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No later than July 1, 2009, all state-owned fueling stations shall provide compressed natural gas fuel, provided the cost of such fuel is not higher than ten percent (10%) over the cost of conventional fuel at the time such fuel is purchased.

B. A state agency owning or leasing a fleet of at least ten vehicles shall increase the fuel efficiency of such fleet by fifty percent (50%) by June 30, 2012 by purchasing vehicles which utilize compressed natural gas fuel if such vehicles are available or converting engines of existing vehicles to utilize compressed natural gas fuel if such conversion is more economical. Such percentage shall be measured against the estimated fuel economy of the fleet on July 1, 2008. Prior to June 30, 2012, such agency may not purchase or lease replacement or additional vehicles with fuel efficiencies less than the fleet average on July 1, 2008.
