Mr./Madame President:

I move to amend Senate Bill No. 2159, Page 18, Line 17,

as follows:

By inserting a new SECTION 5, to read as per attached, by renumbering subsequent sections, and by amending the title to conform.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.20 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any health benefit plan, including the State and Education Employees Group Health Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on or after January 1, 2009, shall provide coverage for benefits provided for preventative health care services including physicals and testing regardless of whether the provider is considered in network for any insurance company. The coverage provided by this section shall be equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contracted allowable, when applicable, or up to, but not more than Medicare allowable for each service when no contract applies. Each laboratory test shall be paid for unless that test is usually included in a "disease-oriented panel" or profile as defined by Federal Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Codes. All laboratory testing shall be paid for when done by an Oklahoma laboratory with Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) certification. The benefit period deductible shall not apply. Covered services are subject to physician's office co-pay only if services are provided in a healthcare facility.
