HOUSE BILL NO. 2485 - By: PROCTOR of the House and CORN of the Senate.

(higher education - Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education - certain
policy on residency for dependents of federal government employees –
noncodification –
emergency)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the
2 Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
4 Education review its state residency policies for tuition and fees, scholarship, and
5 financial aid purposes and adopt a policy that allows the dependents of employees of the
6 federal government who are transferred out-of-state but have retained Oklahoma
7 residency to be charged resident tuition and have the opportunity to participate in all
8 state scholarship and financial aid programs as residents.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
11 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
