COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2667 - By: MCDANIEL (RANDY)  
of the House and FORD of the Senate.

An Act relating to game and fish; providing for a five-year fishing, hunting, and combination hunting/fishing license; establishing the fee for the five-year licenses; making license holders subject to certain restrictions and regulations; establishing fee for issuance of duplicate license; requiring purchase of a five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp; establishing five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee; providing for distribution of the stamp fee; authorizing the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to provide for issuance of the stamp; requiring termination of the stamp and stamp fee upon completion of certain conditions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1           SECTION 1.   NEW LAW   A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 4-113.1 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in  
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4           A. All legal residents who have resided in the state for at least six (6) months may  
5 purchase five-year fishing licenses, five-year hunting licenses or five-year combination  
6 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation Director.

7           B. The fee for these licenses shall be:

- 8           1. Five-year fishing license, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00);
- 9           2. Five-year hunting license, Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00); and

1           3. Five-year combination hunting/fishing license, One Hundred Thirty-five Dollars  
2     (\$135.00).

3           C. The use of the licenses provided in this section is subject to those restrictions  
4     provided by statute and the regulations of the Wildlife Conservation Commission.

5           D. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a duplicate will be issued by the  
6     Department of Wildlife Conservation for a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

7           E. A five-year licensee shall not lose the privileges of such license by a subsequent  
8     transfer of residency.

9           F. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsection B of this section, a  
10    person purchasing a five-year fishing, hunting or combination license shall be required to  
11    purchase a five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. Each person shall have the stamp  
12    in their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any wildlife. The fee for the five-  
13    year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00). The fee for the  
14    stamp shall be distributed as follows:

- 15           a.     Ten Dollars (\$10.00) from each stamp shall be deposited in the  
16                    Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created in Section 4-141 of Title 29 of  
17                    the Oklahoma Statutes, to be used to retire the obligations and related  
18                    expenses as authorized pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the  
19                    Oklahoma Statutes or to purchase, lease, or purchase easements on  
20                    real property to be used as public hunting, fishing, and trapping areas,  
21                    and

1           b.     Two Dollars (\$2.00) from each stamp shall be deposited in the  
2                     Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created in Section 4-141 of Title 29 of  
3                     the Oklahoma Statutes, to be used by the Commission for management  
4                     of the real property acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of  
5                     the Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the Oklahoma  
6                     Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

7           2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall prescribe, by rule, the  
8 form, design, and manner of issuance of the five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

9           3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or defeasance of the  
10 obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the  
11 five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp and five-year Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp  
12 fee requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

13           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2009.
