COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2704 - By: STEELE, DANK, HILLIARD, MCDANIEL (JEANNIE) AND TERRILL of the House and _____ of the Senate.

(request for proposal – long-term care facility – codification -
effective date)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1-849 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:
- 4 A. The State Department of Health shall initiate a request for proposal for the
5 operation of a stand-alone long-term care facility for sex offenders who are assigned a
6 numeric risk level of II or III as provided in the Sex Offenders Registration Act. The
7 request for proposal shall set forth surveillance and security specifications providing for
8 heightened security of residents to protect the public and residents of the facility.
- 9 B. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules and establish procedures
10 necessary to implement the request for proposal and the operation of the stand-alone
11 long-term care facility for Level II and III sex offenders.

1 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall develop an appropriate payment
2 methodology, seek any available federal matching funds, and promulgate any necessary
3 rules for reimbursement weighted in accordance with the heightened security measures
4 required in operating the facilities.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
