COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2892 - By: MORRISSETTE AND SHUMATE of the House and WILSON of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; allowing certain students to enroll in an aviation maintenance technology program offered by technology center school districts; requiring students to meet eligibility requirements; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 14-110.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 Students in the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth grades may be allowed to enroll in an
5 aviation maintenance technology program for high school students offered by a
6 technology center school district, if the student meets all other course work or ability
7 level eligibility requirements.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
11 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
