COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2970 - By: HOSKIN, KIESEL
AND RENEGAR of the House and BURRAGE of the Senate.

An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; providing certain benefits to Oklahoma
veterans; providing certain identification requirements; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 7 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 All honorably discharged veterans who are currently Oklahoma residents shall be
5 allowed free admission to all state-owned or
6 -operated parks and museums. A valid Oklahoma driver license or state photo
7 identification card and military discharge papers (DD Form 214) shall be required for
8 free admission.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
