COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2989 - By: MCDANIEL  
(JEANNIE) of the House and \_\_\_\_\_ of the Senate.

An Act relating to state government; authorizing state agencies to establish a wellness program for employees; providing for certain limitations; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 1385 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
3 reads as follows:

4 In an effort to improve the health status of Oklahomans, any state agency is  
5 authorized to establish and maintain a health and wellness program for employees of the  
6 agency. This program shall be limited to the criteria required to become a certified  
7 healthy business as determined by the State Department of Health.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
