COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 3353 - By: TERRILL, AUFFET, COLLINS, DUNCAN, FAUGHT, LAMONS, LUTTRELL, PROCTOR, SHERRER AND SHOEMAKE of the House and MAZZEI of the Senate.

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending Section 11, Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section 31, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1135.2), which relates to special license plates; expanding eligibility for Gold Star license plates; expanding eligibility of police license plate to include university police officers; creating civil emergency management license plate; restricting eligibility for civil emergency management license plate; creating motorcycle license plate for veterans of United States military service; creating license plate for veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom; amending Section 12, Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section 35, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1135.3), which relates to license plates; discontinuing the Northern Cherokee Nation of the Old Louisiana Territory License Plate; relocating civil emergency management license plate; creating the In God We Trust special license plate; amending Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last amended by Section 25, Chapter 44, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 2006 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1135.5), which relates to special license plates; creating the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation License Plate; creating the Tulsa Police Department Memorial License Plate; creating the Department of Corrections License Plate; providing for deposits into specified funds; creating Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund; providing source of funding; providing for expenditures; stating purpose; creating Tulsa Police Department Memorial License Plate Revolving Fund; providing source of funding; providing for expenditures; stating purpose; creating Department of Corrections License Plate Revolving Fund; providing source of funding; providing for expenditures; stating purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 504, O.S.L. 2004, as last
2 amended by Section 31, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1135.2), is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design
5 and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons in recognition of their
6 service or awards as provided by this section.

7 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be
8 removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license
9 plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
10 registered for the current year.

11 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor
12 license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued
13 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall
14 contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license
15 agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
16 except for legislative plates and amateur radio operator license plates.

17 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a system
18 whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license
19 plates authorized under this section. The motor license agent shall confirm the
20 applicant's eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically
21 authorized by law, accept and process the necessary information directly into such

1 system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor
2 license agents shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for registration
3 of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for acceptance of applications and
4 renewals shall be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

5 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

6 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be designed for honorably
7 discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who
8 were former prisoners of war held by a foreign country and who can provide proper
9 certification of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for
10 no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
11 ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse
12 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce,
13 or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
15 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration
16 fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

17 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be designed for active or
18 retired members of the Oklahoma National Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such
19 plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
20 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

21 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be designed for active or
22 retired members of the Oklahoma Air National Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such

1 plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
2 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

3 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed for active, retired,
4 former or reserve members of the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which
5 branch of service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force,
6 Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member belongs
7 or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably discharged shall not be
8 eligible for such plates. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
9 present or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card
10 or the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or former members
11 who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application,
12 but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

13 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of
15 Honor. Such persons may apply for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license
16 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. There shall be
17 no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

18 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
19 members of the United States Armed Forces who are missing in action. The spouse of
20 such missing person, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the
21 remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
22 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon presenting proper

1 certification that the person is missing in action and that the person making the
2 application is the qualifying spouse or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying
3 spouse and each parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in action
4 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any
6 resident of this state presenting proper certification from the United States Department
7 of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
8 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. Such persons may
9 apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has
11 been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not since
12 remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated by death, divorce or
13 annulment, may apply for such plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
14 (1) ton or less;

15 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any
16 resident of this state who can be verified by the United States Department of Veterans
17 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as being:

- 18 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December 7, 1941,
19 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of 7:55 a.m. to 9:45
20 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor, the island of Oahu, or offshore at a
21 distance not to exceed three (3) miles, and

1 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed
2 Forces.

3 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate for each vehicle
4 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

5 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident of this
6 state who can be verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the
7 Armed Forces of the United States as being:

8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February of 1945,

9 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate vicinity of the
10 island of Iwo Jima, and

11 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed
12 Forces.

13 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

15 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three
16 letters and three numbers. Between the letters and numbers shall be a logo of the flag-
17 raising at Iwo Jima. Below the letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the
18 words "FEB." at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such plates
19 shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by
20 law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year
21 of registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any resident
2 of this state who can be verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or
3 the Armed Forces of the United States as being:

- 4 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6, 1944,
- 5 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of Normandy on June
6 6, 1944; provided, if such participation cannot be verified by the United
7 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
8 United States, the Tax Commission may, in its discretion, accept
9 evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license
10 plate, and
- 11 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed
12 Forces.

13 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a
14 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
16 members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action. The spouse of the
17 deceased person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
18 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action license plate
19 upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed in action and that the
20 person making the application is the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The
21 qualifying spouse may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
22 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee

1 provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall
2 be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
3 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

4 12. Gold Star ~~Parents~~ License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
5 members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed during a war. The parents
6 or surviving spouse of the deceased person may apply for a gold star ~~parents~~ license plate
7 upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed during a war and that the
8 person making the application is the parent or surviving spouse of the deceased person.
9 The parent or surviving spouse may apply for a gold star ~~parent~~ license plate for no more
10 than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
11 less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this
12 paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the
13 registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

14 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any
15 resident of this state who has been awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, the
16 Distinguished Service Cross, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military
17 decoration or the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a military
18 decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
19 less;

20 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed for honorably
21 discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces who served in the

1 Vietnam Conflict. Such persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any currently
4 employed or retired municipal or university police officer. Police officers may apply for
5 police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
6 motorcycle upon proof of employment by or retirement from a municipal or university
7 police department by either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police
8 department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are
9 eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall
10 not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this state; provided, the
12 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
13 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
14 license plate;

15 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
16 honorably discharged former members of the United States Armed Forces who are
17 residents of this state and who can be verified by the Oklahoma Military Department,
18 the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
19 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from September 16, 1940, to
20 December 7, 1945. The former members may apply for a World War II Veteran license
21 plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

1 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center
2 of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia of the 45th Infantry Division in the
3 prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
4 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member belonged. For the
5 purpose of license plate identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the
6 left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the bottom of the
7 license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II";

8 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
9 honorably discharged former members of the United States Armed Forces who are
10 residents of this state and who can be verified by the Oklahoma Military Department,
11 the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
12 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 27, 1950, to January
13 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former members may apply for a Korean War
14 Veteran license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

15 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall contain, in the
16 center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia of the 45th Infantry Division in the
17 prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
18 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member belonged. For the
19 purpose of license plate identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the
20 left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the bottom of the
21 license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

1 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons
2 elected to a municipal office in this state and shall designate the name of the
3 municipality and the district or ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates
4 shall only be produced upon application;

5 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor
6 American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are residents of this state. Such persons
7 must present an identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
8 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with the assistance of the
9 American Red Cross and shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone
10 186C Red. Below the legend the symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than
11 three letters and three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
12 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red Cross" in black. The
13 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates
14 prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
15 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

16 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall be designed to
17 honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any resident of this state who is a
18 member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars organization in this state. Such persons may
19 apply for Veterans of Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a
20 Veterans of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

1 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
2 honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed Forces who served
3 in the Persian Gulf Crisis and the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a
4 Desert Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less;

6 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued
7 to any honorably discharged or present member of a reserve unit of the United States
8 Armed Forces. Such persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor of the bombing attack on the
12 Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

13 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
14 person who is a member of the Civil Air Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air
15 Patrol license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less
16 upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license plate shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

18 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to
19 members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
20 membership in the Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Ninety-Nines;

1 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates – such plates shall be designed to
2 honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. The plate shall have the legend
3 "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three
4 numbers. Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman
5 Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate for each
6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates – such plates shall be designed and
8 issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the United States Armed
9 Forces who saw combat in the United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a
10 Somalia Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of
11 one (1) ton or less;

12 28. Police Chaplain License Plates – such plates shall be designed and issued to
13 members of the International Conference of Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed
14 the ICPC requirements for basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates
15 shall be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

16 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates – such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who has been awarded the Joint Service
18 Commendation Medal by the United States Secretary of Defense;

19 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to
20 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans
21 Affairs, and issued to any person who during combat was a member of the Merchant

1 Marines as certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such license
2 plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons elected to
4 the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate the house of the Legislature in which the
5 legislator serves and the district number;

6 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons
7 presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or
8 the Armed Forces of the United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
9 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which agency pays the
10 disability benefits, or that such veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States
11 government or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
12 for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability rating or due to
13 the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons may apply to the Tax Commission for a
14 disabled veterans license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for
15 no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
16 ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not
17 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
18 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one vehicle with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration
21 fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. The
22 total expense of this license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

1 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate and is also eligible for an
2 insignia as a physically disabled person under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this
3 title, the person shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
4 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a
5 wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license
6 plate with the international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to the Tax
7 Commission;

8 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for members of the United States Air Force Association. Persons applying for
10 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

12 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma
14 Military Academy. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy
15 Alumnus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
16 less. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Military
17 Academy and shall contain the shield of the Academy;

18 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates – such plates shall be designed and
19 issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued
20 by the Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
21 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been installed amateur mobile
22 transmitting and receiving equipment. Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special

1 vehicle identification plates as herein provided. Application for such identification plates
2 shall be on a form prescribed by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and the plates issued to
3 such applicant shall have stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official
4 call letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission to
5 the individual amateur operator thereof. All applications for such plates must be made
6 to the Oklahoma Tax Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for
7 such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee required
8 in this section together with a certificate, or such other evidence as the Tax Commission
9 may require, of proof that applicant has a valid technician class or better amateur
10 operator's license and proof of his ownership of a vehicle in which radio receiving and
11 transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall only be entitled to one set of
12 special identification plates in any one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped
13 thereon. The right to such special identification plates herein provided for shall continue
14 until the amateur radio operator's license of the person to whom such plates are issued
15 expires or is revoked;

16 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members of
17 the American Legion. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
18 membership. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the American
19 Legion of Oklahoma;

20 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any currently
21 employed or retired county sheriff or deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs
22 may apply for such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less upon

1 proof of employment by or retirement from a county sheriff's office by either an
2 identification card or letter from the county sheriff or a government-sponsored
3 retirement board from which the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a
4 pension. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon
5 initial application, but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The
6 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
7 state;

8 38. Surviving Spouse License Plates – such plates shall be designed for any
9 resident of this state who is the surviving spouse of an honorably discharged veteran who
10 died due to or as a consequence of a service-connected disability. Such surviving spouse
11 may, if not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death,
12 divorce or annulment, apply for a Surviving Spouse license plate for one vehicle with a
13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14 39. Gold Star Survivor License Plates – such plates shall be designed to honor the
15 surviving spouses of qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, “qualified veteran”
16 shall mean:

17 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States
18 Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who
19 died as a direct result of the performance of duties for any branch of
20 the United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard while on
21 active military duty, or

1 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States

8 in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
10 each license plate issued;

11 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to
12 any person wishing to demonstrate interest in Oklahoma history. As provided in this
13 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical
14 Society Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

15 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor historic
16 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As provided in this section, an amount of
17 the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving Fund
18 to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma;

19 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued
20 to any person wishing to honor the victims of the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred
21 P. Murrah Federal Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
22 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Heart of the

1 Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes;

3 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person who is an emergency medical technician. Such persons may
5 apply for an emergency medical technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated
6 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's
7 license. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with the state association of
8 emergency medical technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
9 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the person purchasing the
10 plates to be equally apportioned by the county to the city and county volunteer fire
11 departments in the county;

12 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be designed to
13 demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of breast cancer in this state. As
14 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast
15 Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

16 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate awareness of and support for victims of
18 crimes. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime
19 Victims Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
20 apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for the Office of the Attorney
21 General, which is hereby directed to use such funds to contract with a statewide
22 nonprofit organization to provide services to crime victims;

14 Safety pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to
15 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
16 Department of Public Safety to support the Tulsa Police Department Memorial.
17 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
18 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval
19 and payment.

20 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
21 Statutes as Section 1104.18 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in
22 numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes for the Department of Corrections License Plate shall be deposited in
3 the Department of Corrections License Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of
4 this section.

5 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the
6 Department of Corrections to be designated the "Department of Corrections License
7 Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
8 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department of Corrections
9 pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to the
10 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
11 Department of Corrections to support the Oklahoma Correctional Employees Memorial
12 Foundation. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
13 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State
14 Finance for approval and payment.

15 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
