9 AS INTRODUCED

10 A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Oklahoma  
11 Intercollegiate Legislature on the occasion of its  
12 40th legislative session, commending its  
13 contributions to the state; and directing  
14 distribution.

15 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature was founded in  
16 1969 by Governor George Nigh and by college students across  
17 Oklahoma, in order to provide a networking opportunity and a wide  
18 array of experience to students with an interest in politics, law,  
19 or Oklahoma state government; and

20 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature is the longest  
21 consecutively running higher education mock legislative body in the  
22 nation; and

1       WHEREAS, each semester the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature  
2 hosts a five-day mock legislative session in the Oklahoma State  
3 Capitol; and

4       WHEREAS, the mock parliamentary body consists of delegations  
5 from over twenty instate universities; and

6       WHEREAS, the legislation that is passed from the mock session is  
7 forwarded to active legislators who review each for consideration of  
8 adopting into law; and

9       WHEREAS, it is recognized that many current and former  
10 legislators and elected officials are alumni of the Oklahoma  
11 Intercollegiate Legislature; and

12       WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature is celebrating  
13 its 40th legislative session, and will commemorate this event with a  
14 banquet on April 4, 2008, honoring special alumni and celebrating  
15 its forty years of leadership and service.

16       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
17 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
18 CONCURRING THEREIN:

19       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma  
20 Senate congratulates the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature upon  
21 the occasion of its 40th legislative session and celebrates its many  
22 years of leadership and service.
