COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2028 - By: SYKES
of the Senate and JOHNSON (DENNIS) of the House.

An Act relating to guardian and ward; prohibiting concealment or removal
from jurisdiction of certain persons; creating felony offense; providing for
punishment; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 4-904 of Title 30, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:
4 Any individual who maliciously, forcibly or fraudulently takes or entices away any
5 incapacitated or partially incapacitated person, or any other person over the age of
6 sixteen (16) for whom a guardian has been appointed, with intent to detain and conceal
7 such person from his or her guardian or who transports such person from the jurisdiction
8 of this state or the United States without consent of the guardian or the court shall, upon
9 conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment not to exceed ten (10) years.
10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
