COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2173 - By: FORD  
of the Senate and PETERS of the House.

( Amusements and sports – Oklahoma Education Lottery Privatization Act –  
Oklahoma Lottery Asset Review Board – codification – emergency )

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 740 of Title 3A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
3 reads as follows:

4 A. This section shall be known and may be cited as the “Oklahoma Education  
5 Lottery Privatization Act”.

6 B. As used in this section:

7 1. “Board” means the Oklahoma Lottery Asset Review Board as created in this  
8 section; and

9 2. “Concession agreement” means an agreement, including all schedules, exhibits,  
10 and attachments to the agreement, with a concessionaire granting the concessionaire the  
11 contractual right to operate the Oklahoma Education Lottery.

1 C. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Lottery Asset Review Board to be  
2 composed as follows:

- 3 1. The Lieutenant Governor;
- 4 2. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or designee;
- 5 3. The Speaker of the House of Representatives or designee;
- 6 4. The State Treasurer;
- 7 5. The Attorney General;
- 8 6. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 9 7. The Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; and
- 10 8. The Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology  
11 Education.

12 D. The Lieutenant Governor shall serve as chair of the Board. The Board shall  
13 meet at the call of the chair at such times as may be required to perform the duties of the  
14 Board.

15 E. Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their service on the  
16 Board, but shall receive travel reimbursement as follows:

17 1. Legislative members of the Board shall be reimbursed in accordance with the  
18 provisions of Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

19 2. Nonlegislative members shall be reimbursed pursuant to the State Travel  
20 Reimbursement Act.

21 F. The Board shall perform an analysis to ascertain if there is a high probability  
22 that a concession agreement for the operation of the Oklahoma Education Lottery would

1 give more value than the current operation of the lottery by the Oklahoma Lottery  
2 Commission. The Board shall prepare a report of the analysis and shall submit the  
3 report to the Legislature by April 1, 2009.

4 G. The Board may retain advisors, consultants, and attorneys to assist the Board in  
5 performing its duties pursuant to this section.

6 H. The Board shall conclude its duties specified in this section prior to April 1,  
7 2009. The Board shall cease to exist on July 1, 2009.

8 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
10 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
