8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Concurrent Resolution commending the athletic
10 prowess of R.W. McQuarters; commending his
generosity; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Robert Williams (R.W.) McQuarters, II, was born
13 December 21, 1976, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. McQuarters played both
14 football and basketball at Booker T. Washington High School in
15 Tulsa, Oklahoma, and at Oklahoma State University (OSU) in
16 Stillwater, Oklahoma. During this time he established himself as a
17 versatile football player who functioned as a defensive back, a wide
18 receiver, and a kickoff return specialist; and

19 WHEREAS, R.W. McQuarters played in the National Football League
20 (NFL) first with the San Francisco 49ers (1998-1999), then with the
21 Chicago Bears (2000-2004), the Detroit Lions (2005), and finally the
22 New York Giants (2006 to the present). During the last season R.W.
23 McQuarters made key interceptions in divisional playoff games

1 against Dallas, Tampa Bay, and Green Bay, and played on the New York
2 Giants Super Bowl XLII championship team; and

3 WHEREAS, R.W. McQuarters' commercial interests include
4 revitalizing his community by the construction of a strip mall in
5 northern Tulsa. He created the Now Is The Time (NITT) Foundation to
6 help the homeless, those with Multiple Sclerosis, and to help
7 prepare high school students for college entrance exams. In 2007 he
8 cut his dreadlocks and donated them to Locks of Love. McQuarters is
9 one of Oklahoma State University's most generous contributors,
10 donating two and a half million dollars to benefit their football
11 program.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
13 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
14 CONCURRING THEREIN:

15 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature commends the athletic
16 prowess of R.W. McQuarters and congratulates him for his playoff and
17 Super Bowl XLII victories.

18 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature commends R.W. McQuarters'
19 generous charitable donations to his community, college, and those
20 in need.

21 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to New York Giants
22 Super Bowl XLII Champion R.W. McQuarters.
